Preparation- The skin surrounding the surgical area will be clipped and scrubbed with an antiseptic. Equipment used will be sterilized, surgery personnel will antiseptically scrub, wear gloves and protective covering during the operation.

Anesthesia- Local or general anesthesia may be used. Some risk is involved depending on the general condition of your pet, age, and ect. Surgery may occur as scheduled or be delayed depending upon the determination after the pre-surgical examination. Special pre-surgical tests may be requested to ensure a safe anesthesia recovery.

Heart/Respiration- Monitoring of these functions will occur during the operation.

Post-Surgical Care Both staff and Doctor will check your pet continually during the hospital stay and again just prior to discharge. We will discuss take home instructions before releasing your pet. If you wish to discuss this only with the Doctor, please make advance arrangements.
